

# Oakhurst Dairy

Portland, Maine

*Focus on  
Precast Concrete Solutions*



The Oakhurst Dairy of Portland, ME (a family owned dairy since 1921) needed a new cold storage room for the 120,000 gallons of milk produced each day. To blend in with the surrounding downtown buildings and protect all the milk the architect chose a precast concrete facade.

Some of the 12,000 sq. ft. of 7" solid panels were poured with a brick liner. The panels were stained in the field to match the yellow brick of the existing dairy buildings. Also, false windows and joint patterns were added to the exterior face to make the public driving by think this big box was just another building.

Another application where precast concrete gave the architect and owner the flexibility and design freedom to achieve exactly what they had in mind.
