

# Ogunquit Beach Bridge

The Department of Transportation used precast prestressed concrete box girders for the bridge at Ogunquit Beach. 33 Box Girders were required that were 31½" (800mm) in depth in 3 - 71 foot spans. Because Ogunquit Beach is a tourist area, the state of Maine wanted a bridge that would not take away from the aesthetics of the beach; therefore a bridge made with precast concrete girders was an appropriate solution.
